

REFUGEE WEEK WORSHIP KIT

Refugee Week 2015 is being held from Sunday June 14-Saturday June 20. Churches are encouraged to participate on Sunday June 14 or 21 by devoting a section of their church service to prayer for refugees and announcing opportunities to either learn more or take action.

1. SHOW A VIDEO CLIP

Before leading the church in prayer, show the video clip "Qubra and Perez" (three and a half minutes long, downloaded with this kit) in which an Afghani son and mother tell how they became refugees. Showing this clip will help people understand the challenges refugees face and put a human face on their prayer.

2. PRAY FOR REFUGEES

3. LET PEOPLE KNOW ABOUT "BORDERED BY LOVE"

Many Australians are disturbed by our treatment of refugees and asylum seekers, but they don't know what the alternatives are. 4. INVITE PEOPLE TO TAKE FURTHER ACTION

If your congregation has not engaged strongly with the issue of refugees and asylum seekers invite them to participate in a four week small group bible study using the book *Boundless Plains to Share?
